COMMUNITY VITALITY + ECONOMIC RECOVERY

- Attraction to Downtown
- Consideration for various business models
- Consideration for all commercial zones
- Impact on residents
- Compliance with current Santa Clara
 County Public Health Order





COMMUNITY VITALITY

Pop-Up Parks in Parking Lots + Side Streets

- Lot 4 or others
- Parklets similar to Grays Lane on additional side streets
- No tables or high-touch furniture provided
- Programming could include lights, planters, umbrellas, etc.

Temporary Parklets for Business Use

- Utilize parking space(s) in front of restaurants for temporary parklets
- Consideration for business uses to occupy
- Barrier type
- Designated curbside spaces on specific blocks, or in Town parking lots

Closure of Portions of N. Santa Cruz Avenue and/or Main Street

- Extent/size of closure
- Frequency/duration
- Impact on businesses, residents, traffic




PROCESS STREAMLINING



COST • TIME • CERTAINTY Business Retention + Attraction Temporary Considerations

- Current Los Gatos businesses
 - Relocate or expand into without requiring a new CUP
 - Adapt to changing shopping/dining demands



- DRC in the C-2 Zone
- Remove CUP all together
- Allow in limited areas of Downtown
- Extending the expiration date for all building & planning entitlements.
- Consider reducing CUP fees by absorbing the staff costs
 - Vetted through the current process with reduced costs to applicant

- Provide direction on Community Vitality and Streamlining opportunities
- Provide direction for temporary resolution
 - Duration of "temporary" resolution
 - Use of public space
 - Alcohol consumption with meals in pop-up parks/parklets
 - Parking requirements (shopping centers)

 - Banners and A-frames
 - Other opportunities that may require temporary modifications to Town provisions
