FRIENDS OF LOS GATOS PUBLIC LIBRARY WAS ESTABLISHED TO ENCOURAGE USE OF THE LIBRARY FOR THE PURSUIT OF KNOWL-EDGE, INFORMATION AND PLEASURE; TO INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF LIBRARY RESOURCES; TO RAISE FUNDS FOR LIBRARY ENHANCEMENTS; AND TO PROVIDE VOLUNTEER HELP TO THE LIBRARY, ITS PATRONS AND HOME

BOUND LOS GATANS.

Dear Mayor Wasserman and Town Council,

I am pleased to inform you that the Friends of Los Gatos Library voted unanimously at our February 8 board meeting to donate \$5,000 to the Library for the purchase of best sellers and other popular materials to add to the depleted collection. This is a one-time gift, as the Friends ordinarily fund only library enhancements, not operating budget items.

The Friends board's decision to break tradition in contributing \$5,000 to a library operating budget item was prompted by reports from among our over 800 members that popular fiction and nonfiction books were either not available at the library or required being on a reserve waiting list with up to 15 names ahead of them. One member stated that a popular book she wanted was not obtainable at Los Gatos Library, however when checking at the Saratoga Library she learned there were 15 copies of the desired book available with 15 patrons on the reserve list and a wait of only three days.

We are saddened to see entire shelves in the new book section empty, and by the fact that the 60% increase in circulation of the past four years is now dwindling due to our lack of hard copy and electronic materials.

Friends of the Library appreciate and understand the difficult job facing the Council in prioritizing needs and balancing the budget, and we thank you for the time and commitment you give to the community. We hope the library's collection and full operating budget can be restored in the near future.
