

SUBJECT: ADOPT RESOLUTION FOR NATIONAL ARBOR DAY PROCLAMATION
AND ANNUAL OBSERVANCE

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution for National Arbor Day proclamation and annual observance.

BACKGROUND:


The Town annually observes National Arbor Day with a tree planting ceremony. Recognition of National Arbor Day is also a requirement for the "Tree City USA" award. The Town has received the "Tree City U.S.A." award twenty-six (26) years in a row from the National Arbor Day Foundation. The "Tree City U.S.A." Program is sponsored by The National Arbor Day Foundation in cooperation with the National Association of State Foresters and the Department of Forestry. The award is anticipated this year, but delayed due to late application processing.

DISCUSSION:

The Town's commitment to preserve and enhance our urban forest is evidenced by the Town's continued support of the following specific standards: Adoption and enforcement of a tree ordinance; a comprehensive Urban Forestry Program; annual observance of Arbor Day; and, have a legal tree governing body, the Parks Commission.

Los Gatos has a strong commitment to preserving and expanding its urban forest. The community recognizes and supports the functional and aesthetic value of trees.
