ADOPT RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE RETAINING WALL REPLACEMENT AT UNIVERSITY AVENUE AND WOODED VIEW DRIVE AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ADVERTISE THE

PROJECT FOR BID.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution approving plans and specifications for the Retaining Wall Replacement Project at University Avenue and Wooded View Drive and authorize staff to advertise the project for bid.

BACKGROUND:

The adopted Capital Improvement Program designates funding for the retaining wall projects and is consistent with the Town's goals to improve public safety.

DISCUSSION:

Retaining wall repair projects are identified throughout Town and are prioritized in order of repair based on safety issues, roadway impacts, and retaining wall damage.

This project repaired and replaced two failed retaining walls on University Avenue and Wooded View Drive. Two sections of the retaining wall along University Avenue across Vasona Lake failed last winter. Replacement of these walls is necessary due to the large embankment which is above the road and failure of this hillside embankment could cause severe damage to University Avenue.

The new retaining walls are reinforced with steel beams and treated lumber, and the drainage system behind the wall is necessary to prevent water damage. This style of retaining wall is similar to the retaining walls that were constructed on Villa Avenue over the past few years which have a rustic look that blends into the surrounding area. In addition to the University Avenue retaining wall replacement, this contract will also reconstruct a retaining wall on Wooded View Drive which has also failed, and if not replaced, could cause damage to the roadway during the winter rainy months.

Plans and Specifications for this project are complete and will be available for review in the Clerk Department on the Friday before the Council meeting. If Council approves this project, it will be advertised, a construction contract will be presented for Council for award in September and construction is anticipated to begin in early October.

CONCLUSION:

It is recommended that the Council adopt the attached Resolution approving plans and specifications for the Retaining Wall Replacement Project at University Avenue and Wooded View Drive and authorize staff to advertise the project for bids.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

This is a project as defined under CEQA but is Categorically Exempt (Section 15301c). A Notice of Exemption will not be filed.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$561,483 is available in the FY08/09 Capital Improvement Program for Retaining Wall replacement. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$220,000 and \$341,483 will remain unallocated should this project be approved.
