DISCUSSION:

Mayor Mike Wasserman has appointed Council Members to Town boards and committees and various regional commissions, boards, and committees as shown on the attached Council Committee Appointment Roster.

Mayor Wasserman is the appointee to the Santa Clara Valley Water Commission (page 10).
