Review Strategic Goals and Workplan



FY 12/13 Revenue + \$364K

- \$642k increase in <u>Charges for Services</u>
- \$487k increase in <u>Licenses & Permits</u>
- \$225k increase in <u>Monte Sereno reimbursement</u>
- \$127k increase in <u>VLF Property Tax Backfill</u>
- \$416k decrease in <u>Sales Tax</u>
- \$471k decrease in <u>Interest Income</u>
- \$173k decrease in <u>General Property Tax</u>



FY 12/13 Expenditures

- Cost reduction strategies in place
- Mid-year expenses below 50% of budget
- Possible year-end expenditure savings



FY 12/13 Budget Adjustments

Key Recommended Expenditure Adjustments:

Staff Salaries

- \$225k for extra direct homicide investigation costs
- \$70k for staff salaries
- \$45k for Code Compliance

Capital Improvement Projects

- \$50k for Winchester/Lark Intersection Design Phase




Small Town Service ~ Community Stewardship ~ Future Focus

FY 13/14 Budget Development

- Forecasted \$.8m budget gap
 - Prior Council prioritization
 - Updated revenue and expense projections
 - Continued cost containment strategies
