Ordinance Amendment

- Revise the powered equipment section of the Town Code pursuant to Council direction as follows:
 - Gasoline leaf blowers shall be prohibited from use in all residential, commercial, and industrial zones or public space.
 - Electric leaf blowers in excess of 65 decibels, measured 50 feet from the source, shall be prohibited from use in all residential, commercial, and industrial zones or public space.
 - Electric leaf blowers shall be operated only during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays and 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Saturdays in residential, commercial, industrial, public spaces or noise sensitive zones.
 - Leaf Blower use is prohibited on Sundays and holidays.
 - Add a new Section 16.20.070 that addresses enforcement and penalties



Ordinance Implementation

- Ordinance effective July 1, 2014
- Soft enforcement from July 1, 2014-January 1, 2015
 - Warning letters issued only
